**Andrew Robertson - Elective Speaker (Healing and gifts of the Spirit)**

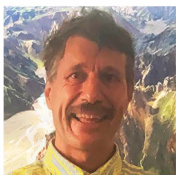
A Pastor in Auckland City 20 years. Alongside the ministry Andrew has owned and operated multiple cafes and restaurants in NZ and in Honolulu. Andrew operates in a strong gift of faith with a healing and deliverance anointing. He has travelled to over twenty nations to share the Gospel and since 2022 overseas ministry has become extensive with many receiving notable miracles and finding Jesus.

**Bruce Beckingsale - Elective Speaker (Writing and share your Testimony)**

His career has been in agricultural extension and consultancy work. In the testimony training elective, you will learn how to frame your testimony, you will prepare a draft version and share it with two other people.

**Bryce Turner - Sunday Morning Speaker**

When God's direction makes us very unpopular, being called to be counter-cultural is a privilege of following God. As society moves further away from God's values, we will inevitably face increasing opposition and may even find our lives threatened. When facing persecution some Christians simply fall away, while others dilute their faith into something more palatable to the world - God asks you to do what?

**Craig Patten - Friday Morning and Elective Speaker (Treasure hunt)**

Why have You worked so many miracles through me Lord? A sheep and a baby raised from dead, a lady raised out of a coma, cancer healed and an ankle with metal in it moving freely without pain. Jesus personally called me and anointed me as a prophet. My whole life changed from doing ministry, to now equipping His people for their ministries.

**Geoff Winter - Friday Afternoon and Elective Speaker (Evangelism)**

A church planter, evangelist, that God has led on the most amazing and fulfilling journey of seeing the Holy Spirit equip and release him to the nation and other nations. Join him in his evangelism workshop and be inspired, trained, equipped, and freshly anointed to step into a new season of harvest, partnering with the Holy Spirit to fulfil your destiny and receive a fresh fire for evangelism.

**Hugh August - Elective Speaker (Holy Spirit and deliverance)**

**Ian Johnson - Friday Afternoon Men's Seminar Speaker**

Ian is a prophetic teacher, revelator, author, and mentor to many. Ian is from the North Waikato region of NZ. Over the years Ian & his wife, Joye, have pioneered and led churches in NZ and travelled extensively to the nations as conference speakers. Having travelled up to 250 days a year internationally, this current season has seen a refocus on the Nation of New Zealand.

**John Knight - Elective Speaker (Resetting worship: Rebuilding Spirit-led intimacy)**

A worship leader ignited by the transformative power of singing a new song. He brings fresh insight into restoring the Tabernacle of David today, emphasising the lost art of intimate small-group worship amid overly complex songs. Sensing a Spirit-led call to deepen worship, musicians will explore chord progressions and voicing, while all attendees can reset their personal worship, fostering renewed closeness with God.

**Keri-Ann Hokianga - Friday Afternoon Woman's Seminar Speaker**

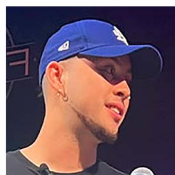
Ko wai ahau? No Te Tairawhiti Manutuke me Pamapuria Kaitaia Ahau. Ko Keri-Ann Hokianga tōku ingoa. I'll be touching on the story of the arrival of the gospel to Aotearoa in 1814. Sharing some of my insights from sharing the gospel out in the community with the unique perspective and from my lens as a full time Māori Evangelist in the Māori Anglican Church since 2020.

**Mark James - Elective Speaker (Tapping into the creativity of God)**

Raised in a Christian home with a science teacher mother who believed in evolution. Mark abandoned his faith when the conflict between these beliefs were made abundantly clear at university, becoming an avowed atheist but re-evaluating his beliefs after marrying a Christian girl. Today he is an Event Manager & speaker for Creation Ministries, sharing that real science does not contradict, but confirms, the truth of the Bible.

**Norm McLeod - Sunday Evening - (Revival South Auckland and the declaration: The great awakening) and Monday Breakfast Speaker**

Norm and his wife, Jess, are Senior Pastors of House of Breakthrough Church in Gisborne. They regularly see miracles and healings that turn people to Christ. Norm is recognised by many as an apostle with a strong prophetic edge who is gifted to help awaken, empower, and deploy God's people to walk in the supernatural power of God.

**Rich Cannon - Elective Speaker (How to interact with the next generation)**

Rich is passionate about equipping the next generation for Christ. He helps young people boldly share the Gospel in their schools and communities. Rich will provide practical strategies for engaging youth with the transformative power of the Gospel and inspiring them to live out their faith. Through creative platforms, Rich uses innovative methods to connect with and impact the next generation for Jesus.

**Richard Brunton - Saturday Breakfast and Elective Speaker (Anointed for work)**

Co-founded Colmar Brunton, NZ's most trusted research company. In 2015, God gave him a powerful revelation about the transformative power of blessing, especially a father's blessing. This insight led him to write the practical life-changing booklets, The Awesome Power of Blessing, followed by Anointed for Work and then The Blessing Effect. Over 2 million copies of his booklets have been sold globally in many languages.

**Tak Bhana - Friday Night Speaker (Prayer and the declaration: Believing for the impossible)**

Tak is a New Zealand born Indian whose life was radically changed at Auckland University when he made the decision to make Jesus Christ the Lord of his life. With his wife, Adrienne, they served as missionaries in the Philippines before becoming pastors of Church Unlimited. Tak is known for his passionate faith in Jesus Christ, for prayer and championing unity in the church.

**Trevor Yaxley - Saturday Night Speaker - (Inspire and the declaration: Permission to dream)**

Trevor won an Export Award for designing bubble wrap in 1978. He then moved into animation as the CEO of Huhu Studios and was one of producers of Promenade's animated version of The Ten Commandments, also the TV series Buzz Poppy and VeggieTales. He had the vision for Lifeway Ministries Trust, which has equipped and released many into various ministries including animation.
